AM. CRANBERRY BUSH VIBURNUM

	A deciduous shrub, growing 8 to 12 feet with a spread to 8 to 12 feet. White flowers, in clusters in May. Bright red berries early September through fall into February, which provide food for birds. People used to make jelly from the berries. Use as a screen or a background plant, space 4 feet apart. A good wetland plant. Seedlings 8-12 inches. 6 per package, \$8.00 per package.
<u>RED OAK</u>	Native tree growing 60 to 70 feet with equal spread. Leaves hang on long into fall and early winter. A good yard tree because of its fast growth and tolerance for harsh conditions like road salt and ozone. Also a valuable timber tree. 2Yr. Seedlings 8-16 inches. 6 per package, \$8.00 per package.
