



Fayette County Conservation District ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE Scholarship

**General Information**

The Fayette County Conservation District is offering multiple \$1,500.00 scholarships to students from Fayette County for the 2026/27 academic year. They will be awarded to students enrolled in an **agriculture** related major or program, or an **environmental science** related major or program.

**ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS:**

- A. The applicant must be a resident of Fayette County.
- B. The applicant must be enrolled in or accepted into an Environmental Science or related field of study for the 2026/2027 academic year. Examples of Environmental Science related programs include but are not limited to: Environmental Resources Management; Soil & Natural Resources Conservation; Wildlife & Fisheries Management; Aquatic Ecology; Forest Ecosystem Management; Geographic Information Systems (GIS); Recreation, Parks & Tourism Management; Environmental Education; Bio-renewable Systems; Energy & Sustainability; Landscape Architecture and more. Determination of whether your major course of study qualifies will be at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the FCCD. If you are not sure your program is eligible, contact the FCCD office.
- C. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Conservation District Board of Directors without regard to race, color, religion, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, disability or protected veteran status.

**ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

The applicant will submit:

- \* Completed FCCD *Environmental Science Scholarship* application
- \* A copy of school/program acceptance letter/student ID
- \* List of involvement in extra-curricular activities *within your chosen field of study*
- \* Essay conveying why you are entering this particular field of study

Completed applications for the scholarship must be received at the Conservation District office by 3:30 PM May 1, 2026. The scholarship recipients will be notified on or about June 2, 2026.
